iNARTE VISION STATEMENT

iNARTE shall be recognized as the premier independent certification organization which provides standards of excellence attainable to technical professionals in Telecommunications, Electromagnetics, Electrostatics, Product Safety Engineering and related areas.

About iNARTE Accredited Universities, Schools & Training Institutes

NARTE was established by industry leaders in 1982 in response to the FCC's deregulation and encouragement of industry certified personnel. As an objective third party certification body, NARTE developed an evaluation process based not only on examination, but real world skills and work experience. In 2006, NARTE became iNARTE to recognize our growing international membership.

To become listed as an iNARTE Accredited University, School or Training Institute you must submit a detailed curriculum of the courses offered that are pertinent to one or more of the disciplines in which iNARTE offers certification. You must also complete the applicable forms provided. You may also be requested to proctor iNARTE certification examinations as an Authorized Test Center, but this is not mandatory. To become listed as an Authorized Test Center you must complete additional application forms provided on our web site, read and sign the "iNARTE Authorized Testing Center and/or Individual Proctor Responsibilities, Procedures and Rules" at the end of this package and return them to: iNARTE, 840 Queen St., New Bern, NC 28560, or fax to: 1-252-672-0111

The iNARTE Accredited status may be conferred on a University, School or Institute offering courses directly related to an iNARTE Certification discipline. As such, you will be listed on the iNARTE web site; we will promote your services to our certification candidates and to the industries at large. You will receive the appropriate display certificate and you will be allowed to use the iNARTE logo in the promotion of your educational services.

As an Accredited University, School or Training Institute, your graduating students are qualified, without further examination, to apply for certification as an iNARTE Junior Engineer or Junior Technician, if graduating from a Telecommunications curriculum, or as an Affiliate Engineer or Affiliate Technician if graduating from another iNARTE discipline. Graduates from other than a Telecommunications curriculum wishing to apply for Associate Certification will be required to have achieved a final Grade Point Average, (GPA), of better than 3.0, or equivalent.**

All applicants from an Accredited University, School or Institute will also be awarded one year of experience credit for each year of their applicable undergraduate studies. This entry-level iNARTE Certification will enhance each graduate's qualifications as they proceed to joining the work force.

Any graduate wishing to take advantage of this offer will need to complete the appropriate Application form, (available from our web site). This form must be submitted to iNARTE, together with a copy of their transcript and a letter of recommendation from a Head of Department, a Professor or a Tutor who is familiar with their work. Other requirements for certification are detailed on the Application form and differ for each discipline.

To be considered for Accreditation you must complete this application form and provide a comprehensive course curriculum, together with a description of the degrees, scholarships or certificates that you award and the award requirements.

*** Any graduate wishing to apply for Associate Certification who has not achieved the required GPA will be required to pass a short form iNARTE Examination in the chosen discipline.*
