The Global Laboratory Accreditation Initiative:

In November, 2000, 36 Laboratory Accreditation Bodies, all members of the International Laboratory Accreditation Cooperation, (ILAC), and representing 28 separate global economic regions, signed a mutual recognition arrangement to promote the acceptance of technical test and calibration data for exported goods. The aim of this ILAC Arrangement was to develop a global network of accredited testing and calibration laboratories that can be relied upon to provide accurate results.



Today, 60 Laboratory Accreditation Bodies from 47 global economies are signatories to this ILAC Arrangement. The strength of the ILAC Arrangement is to establish a global network of accredited test and calibration laboratories that have been assessed and recognized as competent by Accreditation Bodies that are signatory to the ILAC Arrangement. Each member laboratory of this global network and each laboratory that comes forward for assessment should have at least one person designated as the **Laboratory Auditor**.

The **Laboratory Auditor** must understand the detailed requirements to pass assessment and will have the skills and initiative to ensure that the Laboratory achieves and maintains a Quality Program in accordance with ISO/IEC 17025.

Course Description: ACLASS together with iNARTE jointly offer the iNCLA training course as a 4-day program that is designed to prepare the attendees to meet several qualifications and competencies toward iNARTE Certification as an Internal Laboratory Auditor. The course is a fortified version of traditional internal auditor programs for ISO/IEC 17025. It includes not only full coverage of the ISO/IEC 17025 standard, but emphasizes both the quality and technical competencies that need to be demonstrated by a laboratory that is seeking or planning to maintain its accreditation to the international standard. The intent is to have certified auditors with rigorous training and verification of ability to help the laboratory display the competence and records needed for maintaining the international standard. The target audience therefore would include managers, engineers and other technical staff responsible for preparing laboratories for assessment and maintenance of laboratory quality according to ISO/IEC 17025. There will be heavy emphasis on technical elements such as uncertainty, proficiency testing, metrological traceability and technical method witnessing and validation.



The successful completion of the course will involve passing a 4-hour examination on the final day.

The ANSI-ASQ National Accreditation Board, ACLASS, is a non-profit, non-governmental organization that provides accreditation services to public- and private-sector organizations. ACLASS is one of two brands of the ANSI-ASQ National Accreditation Board, jointly owned by the American National Standards Institute and the American Society for Quality. The ACLASS portfolio covers the spectrum of third-party conformity assessment accreditation.



iNARTE is a worldwide, non-profit, professional credentialing association which certifies qualified engineers and technicians.
